The previous Minor Injury Unit will be replaced by the new, GP-led Urgent Treatment Centre on **1st August 2019**. If you have an injury or illness that is **not life/limb threatening**, the Urgent Treatment Centre can provide prompt assessment, advice and/or treatment.

If you are in any doubt over where to go, talk before you walk by calling NHS 111. A UTC appointment can also be booked by the NHS 111 team after an initial telephone assessment. If it's an emergency, always dial 999.



What are Urgent Treatment Centres?

The Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC) treats a similar range of conditions as the previous Minor Injury Unit, including illnesses.

UTCs are GP-led and have access to X-ray facilities and patient diagnostic testing including: urine tests, blood glucose testing and electrocardiogram (ECG) testing (which measures the electrical activity of your heart to show whether or not it is working normally).

This allows GPs and practitioners to assess and diagnose more conditions as well as the ability to prescribe medication and provide onward referrals to appropriate healthcare departments - giving you faster access to the treatment you need.

For non-life threatening treatment, support your local Emergency Department by attending the RSH Urgent Treatment Centre.
