DID YOU KNOW?

- You can sign up electronically to a pharmacy of your choice. This means that your prescriptions can be sent directly to the pharmacy and will save you time having to pick it up (local pharmacies are easier for us to communicate with if any difficulties)

How ?

- Ask either our receptionists so that they can add your chosen pharmacy to your records OR you can ask your pharmacist to add this

Did you know?

- Regular repeat medication can be sent in batches to your pharmacy.

How ?

If you are on regular medication, we can send several months of prescriptions directly to the pharmacy ahead of time. This means that when your medication is due, you can go direct to the pharmacy to pick up your medication. This means that you no longer have to request your prescription ahead of time as the work is already done for you. At the end of the batch, you will still need to arrange your regular checks at the surgery prior to a new batch being dispensed.
